





Outdoor Christmas Scavenger Hunt; go outside and see what you can discover! How many of these items can you find? Tick the box next to each item once you've found it.

Can you find some sticks? What animals make their homes under stick piles? What can we do in our own homes that reflects the real meaning of Christmas?




## **Footprints**
